

Ticketing systems and Fares from Baiyappanahalli to Mahatma Gandhi Road

Ticketing System and fares:

The Tickets for Performing Journey on Namma Metro will be available in the form of:

a) Contactless Smart Tokens (CST)

b) Contactless Smart Cards (CSC)

(i) Stored value ticket - VARSHIK

(ii) Trip tickets - SANCHAR

c) Group Tickets

d) Integrated Metro-Bus ticket

A) Contactless Smart Tokens (CST): Tokens are to be touched on the pad of the entry gates on station Entry gate and dropped into the slot at the Exit gate of the exit station. Tokens are available at stations at the ticket counters. Each token is for single journey only. Each person can procure up to six tokens for five additional passengers travelling with him. Each passenger has to carry the token on their in person.

B) Contactless Smart Cards (CSC): CSCs are available at stations for performing multiple journeys. CSCs provide benefit of discounted fares in the form of Stored Value tickets and Trip tickets. The CSC shall be available for purchase by passengers for ₹ 50/-. This cost of the CSC is non-refundable and different from the stored value of a CSC. After purchasing the CSC, the commuter can load VARSHIK or SANCHAR or both tickets in the same CSC to the required value or Trips..

(i) **Stored Value tickets** (named as **VARSHIK**) has money value stored in it and gets reduced to the extent journey is performed. VARSHIK is valid for one year from the date of last 'ADD VALUE'. Following limits are applicable for Stored Value Ticket in a CSC when value is being added to it.

- Minimum stored value - Nil
- Multiples of stored value to be loaded - ₹ 50/-
- Maximum stored value - ₹ 1500/-


Apart from metro stations, adding value to Varshik will be possible through 1) ATMs / Net banking / mobile Banking of all State Bank of India, 2) BMRCL website and 3) scratch cards through SMS.

The date of availability of upload through BMRCL web site and upload through starch cards will be notified separately.

- (ii) **A Trip Ticket** (named as **SANCHAR**) has a fixed number of trips (10, 40, 50 or 100 trips) stored into it. One Trip is a journey with an 'Entry' followed by an Exit from a station. Trips can be purchased in advance for performing journeys between any two stations and this is beneficial for commuters travelling regularly between fixed places (Ex : For Office goers, Businessmen, Students etc) as these tickets are available at discount ranging from 5 to 10 % over VARSHIK rates. These Trips can also be used between other pairs of stations having the same or less fare. SANCHAR 10, is valid for 1 month, SANCHAR 40 and 50 are valid for 3 months and SANCHAR 100 is valid for 6 months from the date of last 'ADD TRIP'.

- C) **Group Tickets:** Group tickets in the form of **paper tickets** are issued to a Group of minimum of 10 passengers travelling together between same set of stations. These tickets are manually checked at separate entry / exit gates at the stations. These tickets are discounted at 10% of Token fare for each passenger.
- D) **Integrated Metro-Bus ticket:** BMRCL and BMTC are jointly introducing daily pass viz. integrated Metro – Bus ticket (MBT pass) to enable passengers to perform unlimited journeys in Namma Metro and BMTC buses for the day. These are available in BMTC Buses and Metro stations. Passengers have to purchase the CSCs (if not already having) to avail this facility. There are two categories of MBT pass viz SARAL and SARAAG. The SARAL ticket costing ₹ 110 entail a passenger to perform journey in all BMTC buses (except Airport services) and Metro. The SARAAG ticket costing ₹ 70 entails a passenger to perform journey in BMTC non air-conditioned buses and Metro.



NOTE:-

1. Minimum Fare will be charged for entering into a station.
2. Time Limit: The maximum permissible time limit between entry and then exit from 'paid area' of the same station is 20 minutes and for stay in the entire system i.e. entry/ exit from 'paid area' of different station is 120 minutes. For stay beyond permissible limit, the commuter will be liable for eviction from the station, levy of penalty at the rate of ₹ 10 per hour subject to a maximum of ₹ 50.
